

TWO NEW TYPES OF SCHOLARSHIPS IN 2024

The Wapakoneta Area Community Foundation administers 43 scholarship funds. Most of these scholarships were established by individuals, families, and civic organizations. They are all focused on high school senior applicants. This year, the Foundation is creating two new scholarship opportunities.

NON-TRADITIONAL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is intended for students who did not go directly to college after high school. Students who went directly to work or began to raise a family. It can also include local residents who now choose to make a career change that requires additional education. Financial need will be a primary consideration for this scholarship. Scholarship amount: \$2,500

GRADUATE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is intended for area residents who are planning to be new, first-time graduate students. The scholarship will be for adults seeking a new graduate degree to enhance or change their career. These may be college graduates who may have been out of college for several years, but now want to earn a graduate degree. Financial need will be a primary consideration for this scholarship. Scholarship amount: \$2.500
